Frankenmuth Wickson District Library to Request Additional Millage on August 4, 2026 Ballot

The Frankenmuth Wickson District Library wishes to inform the community that it will be requesting voter approval of an additional 0.85 mills on the August 4, 2026, election ballot.

If approved, the additional millage would provide essential funding to support the library's daily operations, including staffing, materials, programs, facility infrastructure, and potential capital improvements.

Like many public institutions, the library continues to face rising costs for materials, employee wages, operational expenses, and the ongoing maintenance and replacement of building infrastructure. This additional revenue is requested to help ensure the library can continue to maintain current services and resources that meet community needs now and in the future.

The Frankenmuth Wickson District Library is committed to transparency and accountability in its operations and finances. Community members are encouraged to learn more about the proposed millage by visiting www.wicksonlibrary.org or by contacting the library directly with questions.

Residents are encouraged to stay informed, conduct their own research regarding the upcoming election, and, most importantly, to vote.
